Dear Parents,

Here are some suggestions and helpful hints for planning your Bar/Bat Mitzvah at Congregation Beth David:

Speak to the President and/or the Bar/Bat Mitzvah Committee at least one year in advance, about the following important matters:

The child must be Jewish according to Conservative Jewish law.

You must meet the requirements of membership in Congregation Beth David, and be member(s) in good standing, in order to celebrate your child's special day in our Sanctuary. Current family annual dues are \$450.00.

There is a fee of \$200.00 to the Shul for costs related to the event, including the fee for the Religious Leader. This fee is due and payable when the date is scheduled.

Access to the Shul can be arranged for flower delivery prior to Friday evening services, well before sunset - preferably by mid-afternoon)

Contact Rev. Ethan Adler at least a year in advance regarding Haftarah tapes, the structure and order of the Services, the customary parts to be learned for the ceremony, etc.

Please be aware that any food that comes into the Sanctuary must be certified kosher. For the Oneg Shabbat and the Kiddush, this includes kosher wine, and baked goods from a kosher bakery.

Also, no photography, or audio or video recording of any kind is permitted during the Service. Pictures can be arranged before or after the Service with the Religious Leader.
